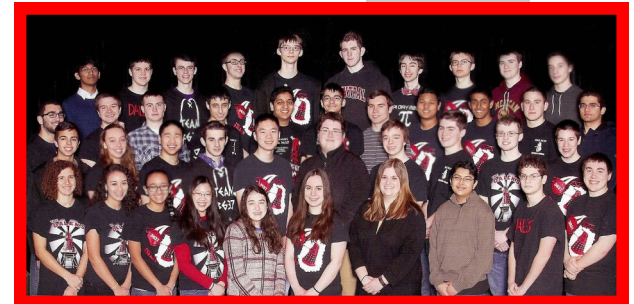

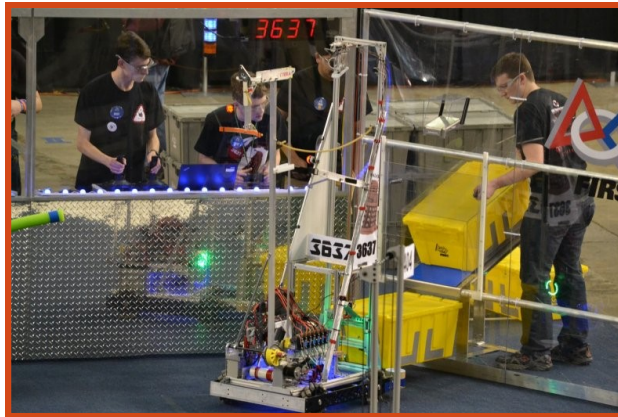
## ABOUT THE DALEKS
